Officer Reports

President Report

- SDOT is updating bike master plan - David commented:
 - top of Admiral hill at viewpoint is a tight road for bike lane
 - tough, busy, complex corner under Spokane St high bridge 5-way corner
 - bike improvements to E. Marginal & from capital savings on Spokane St. viaduct are underway
