- ❖ Chas Redmond did California Ave SW historic survey with Susan Melrose, Executive Director of Junction Bus.:
 - The two did a subjective first cut survey of notable building last year.
 - Difficult to create historical district.
 - Has to be some integration of structures to make a district.
 - Importance of area itself.
 - Length of California Ave doesn't fit.
 - Met with a number of architects.
 - Best approach seems advised to be overlays –
 - e.g. design review or street design

- try and tie parcel numbers to historic events in W.S.
- Have \$12k grant to do a portion of survey, will start in Admiral.
- Outcome is to have description of what makes California Ave “California Ave”, preservation of viewscape and preservation of notable buildings.

- ❖ Tod Redmond – W.S. Transportation Coalition:
 - Strategy – engage with city to develop plan for mass transit and
 - If Olympia doesn’t pass transportation package may have 17% cuts, extra cuts in W.S. because traffic mitigation fund will be cut as well.
